DULL MEDIUM



Deep Reddish Orange Brown with stitch water marking. Four to six known.



Medium Orange Brown for comparison



Very deep Reddish Orange Brown with more red, triple transfer. Colorization by Dr. Amonette. Position 74li platted by Dick Celler. Not in the Amonette or Hulme sales. Triple transfer not listed in Scott. Very rare.



Experimental Orange Brown with a Louisville and Cincinnati Mail Line Ohio River steamboat hand stamp. Ex Amonette.



Bright Orange Brown. Very rare. None seen at auction unless perhaps in some Amonette color studies.
