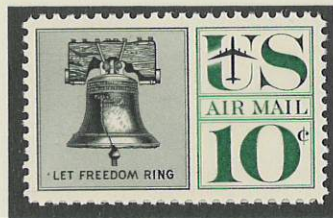






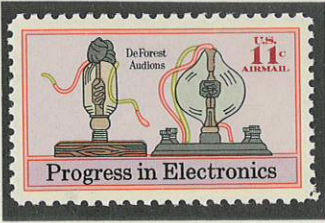






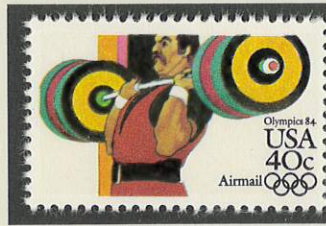


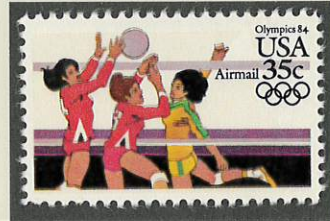


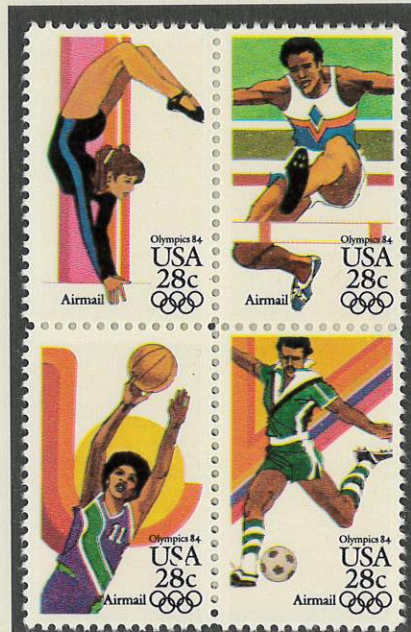
















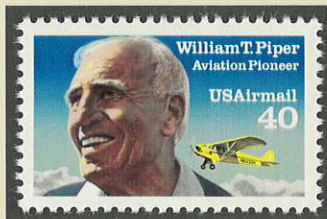
## 20<sup>th</sup> Universal Postal Congress
