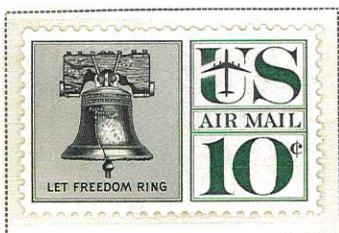

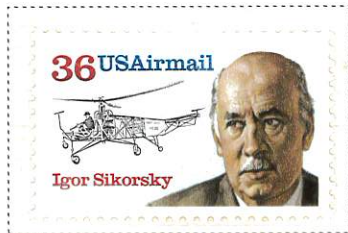

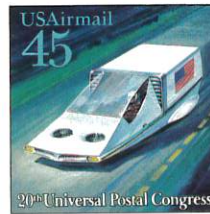


20th Universal Postal Congress
