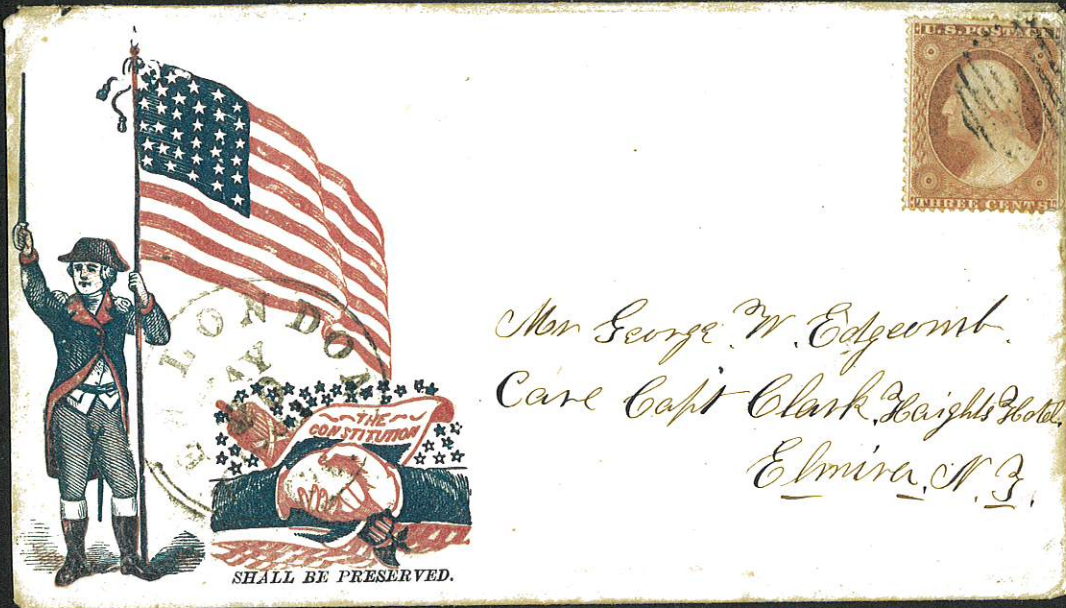
Hail glorious Flag! we cherish thee,

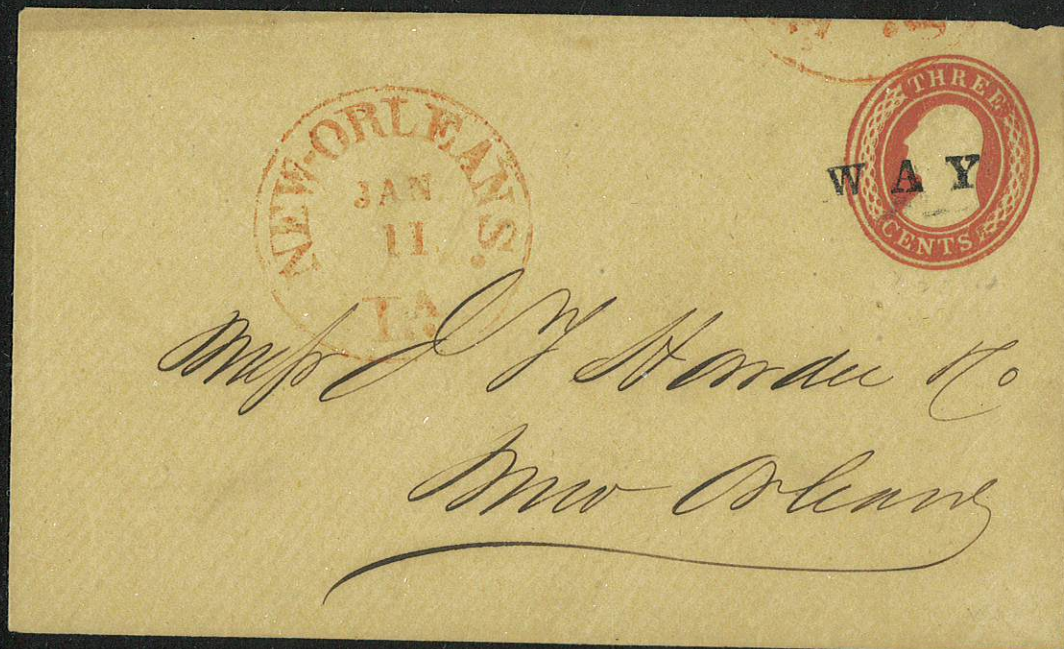

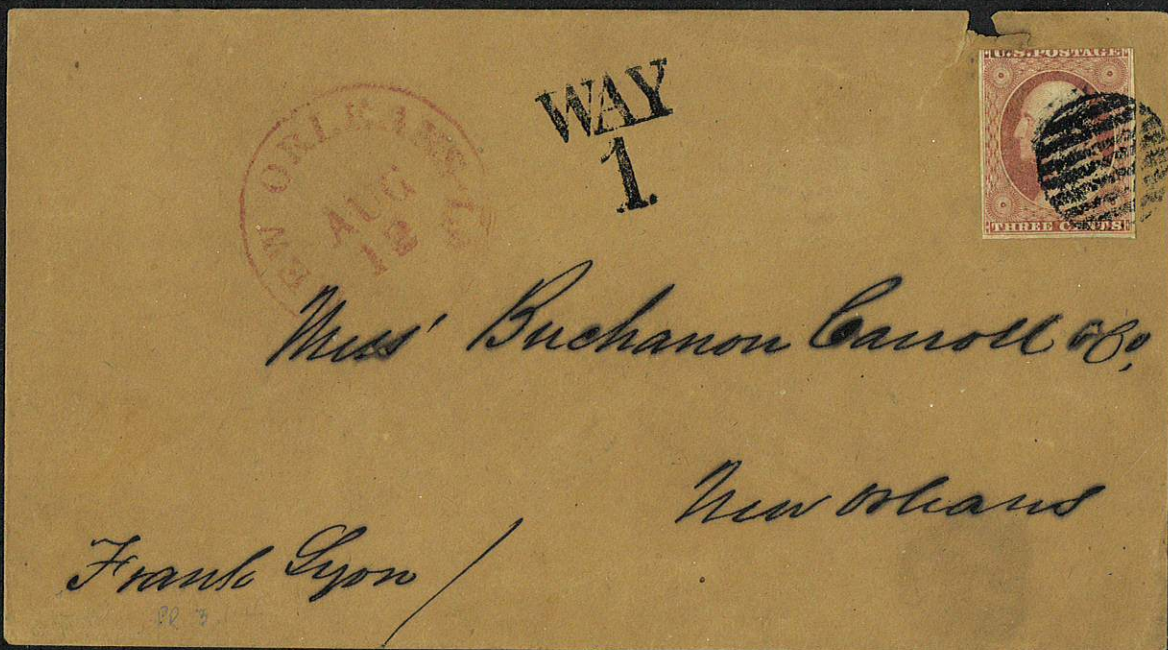
