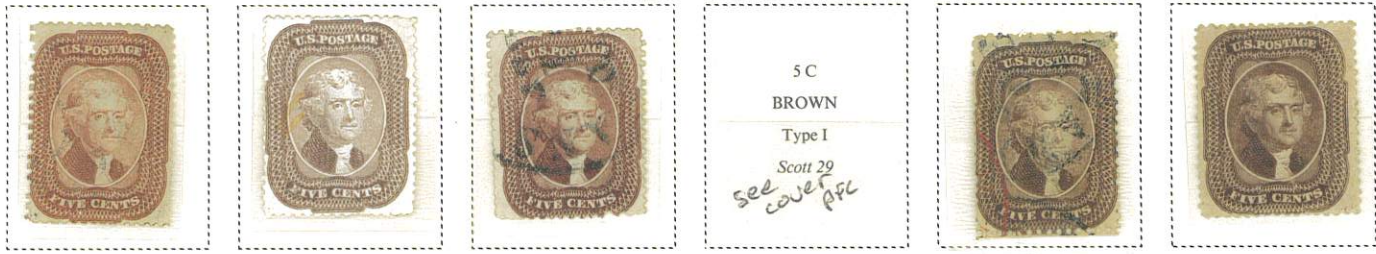

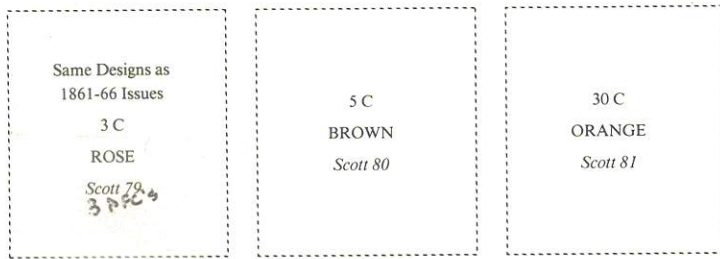

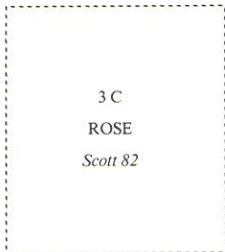

about 18 x 15 mm.

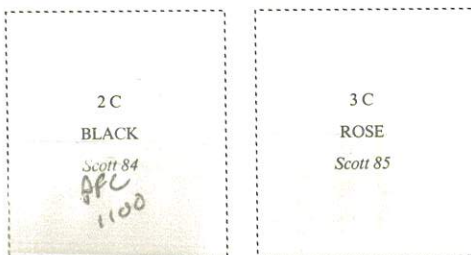


C. Grill measuring
about 13 x 16 mm.

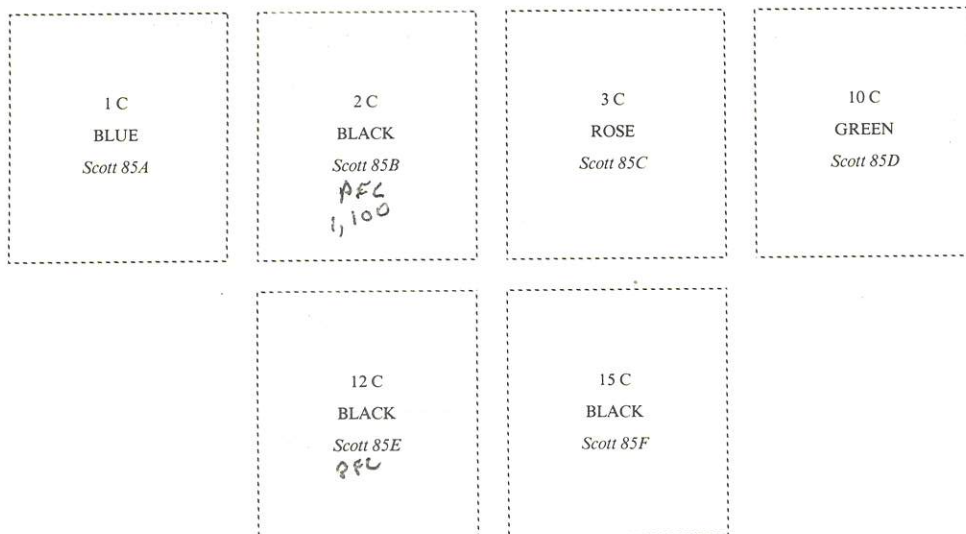


GRILL WITH POINTS DOWN
